Program Description: SVNH is looking for a part-time Food Hub Operations Programmer to support the South Vancouver Community Food Hub, an initiative in partnership with United Way BC and our network of 10+ community partners. Currently, we provide dignified, culturally appropriate food access for 330 households across 6 locations in the Sunset, Victoria-Fraserview and Killarney neighbourhoods.

We are looking for a friendly, organized, and initiative-taking individual who is passionate about food justice issues to join our Food Team. The Food Hub Operations Programmer will work closely with the Food Security Coordinator to run internal operations at the SVNH Food Hub, which is located on W 49th Ave and Alberta St in Vancouver.

The successful candidate will:

- Lead volunteers to sort and pack healthy food boxes for families, seniors and residents experiencing food insecurity.
- Train and support volunteers to be engaged, clear on tasks and follow Food Safety and Occupational Health & Safety standards.
- Submit regular food orders and pursue new procurement partnerships with businesses for donated and purchased food.
- Help coordinate weekly food deliveries and pick-ups, track inventory, sort donated food, and ensure food is distributed in a timely manner according to the program's weekly schedule.
- Maintain a welcoming, inclusive environment and create positive relationships with program partners, volunteers and participants alike.
- Maintain an organized and tidy warehouse. Ensure equipment is used safely and well-kept.
- Incorporate community and volunteer feedback into program delivery.
- Support volunteer management, community engagement and fundraising as needed.

- Interpersonal and organizational skills are a must
- Experience working in a multi-cultural, community setting, preferably with adults and seniors.
- Experience and/or education in food security, food services, or non-profit sector.
